LANDSCAPE PROJECTS OF HAGER PARTNERS

Rudolf Bednar Park, Vienna, Austria (2008).

A new city district is being created in Leopoldstadt: Where once there was a train station there is now city; where once there was industry, there is now a park. The «veil of trees» takes up the orientation of the nearby Danube River and of the former train tracks, and anchors the park in the future district of the city. Under its canopy are various areas ranging from utilization-intensive play and sport fields for young people to calmer uses in the «Quartiersgärten» framed with blossoming hedges, or the orange-colored play steles on which children can climb or swing.

New Rhine River Promenade St. Johann Basel (2016).

A new public promenade for pedestrians and cyclists has now been created on the bank of the Rhine River between St. Johanns Park and the French border, which was previously the site of a closed harbor area. The promenade is the result of nine years of planning and constructions. The over 600-meter-long promenade between the Rhine and the Novartis Campus is only ten 10 to 30 meters wide, but overcomes a height of up to 10 meters. The design is based on the current. The walls needed to bridge the difference in heights take up the oscillating movement and continue it in the path areas.

Private Garden J., Berlin, Germany (2008).

A gas station from the 1950s has been remodeled into a residential building with studio. In the densely built up district of Schöneberg, gaps between buildings are retained. Tall pines and ornamental cherry trees with multiple trunks replace volume. High walls and a bamboo hedge shield it from outside view. In front of the roof over the gas pumps lies a water lily canal with water jets. In the bamboo and central sand surface, bloom white foxtail lilies next to bluebells and self-seeding foxglove, lilies and columbine – a wild see-ming garden in the middle of a agile and creative city.
